FLOUR MIXES,OIL ETC.) TO HAICL SPECIFIED DELIVERY POINTS WITHIN
THE STATE OF HARYANA**

Government of Haryana has launched Retail Expansion Plan project(Under brand Name "Har-Hith"), this project is implemented by Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited, for set-up of franchisee based retail outlets .Broad objective of the project is to provide an alternate channel to promote entrepreneurship, provide best quality products at discounted prices, help in promoting State owned MSME/NGO/SHG/FPO and other manufacturer with in the state, to promote retail policy of Haryana Government and to generate employment across the State. Going forward, the organization would help generate market for innovative products across perishable & consumer goods that will further promote entrepreneurship and manufacturing efficiency in the State.

It has been proposed to set up 2000 retail stores/outlets across the 22 districts of Haryana, which will help in boosting the spirit of entrepreneurship and generating favorable employment.

For this purpose, HAICL intends to invite EOI from Manufacturer/Processors/Suppliers, meeting minimum criteria as specified in Para C & D, for supply of essential commodity products (Pulses, Spices, Sugar, Rice, Dry Fruits, Cereals & Cereal Products, Flour & Flour Mixes, Oil etc.) to specified delivery points within the state of Haryana both for Har-Hith supplies as well as to cater the need of Institutional client.

The application form and other terms & conditions may be downloaded by the interested parties from HAICL website www.haic.co.in and www.agribazaar.com and www.neml.in.Currently, the interested parties are advised to register at www.agribazaar.com and www.neml.in.

1. Intending Processors/Suppliers shall submit application online in the prescribed format (duly filled in) along with supporting documents
2. HAICL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reason thereof. The issue of this document does not in any way commit or otherwise obliges HAICL to proceed with all or any part of EOI process. The EOI is not the subject of any process of contract or any contractual obligations between HAICL and prospective manufacturer/processor/supplier.

Introduction

HAICL invites application from Manufacturers/Processors/Suppliers for various varieties of essential commodity products (Pulses, Spices, Sugar, Rice, Dry Fruits, Cereals & Cereal Products, Flour & Flour Mixes, Oil etc.), meeting minimum eligibility as described in Para C of this document.

HAICL has engaged private service provider M/s Star Agribazaar and M/s NCDEX e-Markets Ltd to facilitate bidding process from the selected manufacturers/processors/suppliers for procurement through online platform. In such a case, the selected manufacturers/processors/suppliers will be required to register on portal in order to participate in the bidding process. The bidding process shall be based on reverse bidding.

A. Scope of Work:

a. Registration on E-Portal of HAICL and supply conditions

Selected manufacturers/processors/suppliers will be required to get themselves registered on <https://www.agribazaar.com> and www.neml.in portal appointed by HAICL for bidding assistance for procurement process.

- i. The interested suppliers are requested to submit all the requisite documents at the website. HAICL and Star Agri Bazaar will check/verify the document and proceed/register with eligible application for participation in bidding in future. For further assistance kindly contact Mr. Jai Bhagwan from Agribazaar Team at contact no. 7507011222 or Mr. Virender Chaudhary from NeML team at contact no.7021355750 or Ms. Pooja Kundoo from HAICL side at contact no. 9654971043.
- ii. Manufacturer/processor/supplier will be required to authorize a person to manage online bids through bidding portal.

b. Participation in Bidding Process

- i. Selected manufacturer/processor/supplier will be intimated by HAICL and the e-portal service provider about the tenders/contracts listed in portal on regular basis.

The contract will provide details including quality specifications for products, order quantity, delivery points and timelines. The supplies should be ensured test report from a NABL accredited lab.

- ii. Manufacturer/processor/supplier will be required to deposit an EMD before participation in the bidding process. The successful bidder will submit 2% security deposit of total contract value, whereas EMD amount will be Rs. Rs.5000(Five thousand only) for Harhith supplies and Rs.10,000(Tender Thousand only) for Institutional supplies per bidding. The EMD amount of unsuccessful participants will be returned.
- iii. The selected manufacturer/processor/supplier will be required to do F.O.R. deliveries at HAICL specified delivery points within Haryana, for institutional supplies location will be specified as per requirement of institutional client, same will be mentioned in contract note,
- iv. Product that HAICL is buying via e-bidding and have forward linkage then MD, HAICL is authorized to seek both ex-mill and F.O.R. rates in case of institutional supplies on basis of designated place as confirmed by institutional client, same will be mentioned in contract note.
- v. The selected manufacturer/processor/supplier will be required to supply products in the pack sizes and packaging specified by HAICL.
- vi. The selected manufacturer/processor/supplier will be required to supply products as per grades specified in tender document floated along with contract note on bidding platform.
- vii. Neither the Department nor the concerning authority will be responsible for any fluctuation of prices in Domestic Market or International Market and no request or representation for revision of rate will be entertained.

c. Sampling: -

In case of Institutional supplies, as per requirement of institutional client, sample need to be submitted, same will be specified in contract note. In case of Har-Hith supplies minimum 08 samples per products need to be submitted in HAICL H.O. after winning successful bid, Work order will be issues/PO will be raised only after sample approval.

d. Quality Assurance (Visual Appearance and Lab Testing): -

- i. HAICL reserves the right to upgrade/modify the specifications of the items from time to time.
- ii. Visual inspection of the sample shall be done at time of receiving of goods and same shall be compared with the master sample received earlier by HAICL appointed officer before accepting supplies.
- iii. Before accepting supplies any random pack of items will be/may be subject to Lab testing as per specification and same can be compared with Lab testing report submitted by supplier, if Lab testing report is not found satisfactory or in

accordance with sample submitted, a penalty as per contract note will be imposed.

- iv. Every product in the Processed Nutritious/Supplementary Food Items must have product certificate from the respective brands stating:
- Date of Manufacture
 - Date of Expiry
 - Not for Sale. For free distribution by Government of Chhattisgarh.
 - Nutritional value per 100 gms.

e. Warranty of Material: -

- i. The supplier shall be responsible for quality of the material being supplied to HAICL as per shelf-life criteria specified in accordance with FSSAI guidelines. Same will be mentioned in contract note.
- ii. Quality should not deteriorate in terms of soundness, wholesomeness and fitness for human consumption provided the required commodity items after supply by manufactures/Suppliers, are properly stored in ambient conditions by Government authorities.
- iii. The suppliers should meet the requirement of HAICL specifications and suppliers will be responsible for any legal action under FSSAI or any other statutory provision arising due to any non-conforming quality of supplies as per these specifications.
- iv. Commodity Items should have shelf life as per FSSAI specifications only and all the items should be labelled with FSSAI certification number, nutritional values per 100 gm should be printed on each product in case of processed food items.

f. Penalty clause for quality or Delay:-

- i. For any supply delay, a penalty will be charged from the seller. Upto two week @ 2% per week of the cost of the material. After 2 weeks the penalty will be imposed @ 4% per week of the cost of the material. In case of delayed supply, HAICL reserves the right to cancel the trade and source the balance quantity from open market at risk & cost of the seller. However, the delay can be condoned at the discretion of the Managing Director. Default in supplies either wholly or partly, post extended delivery period, on account of quality or quantity or delay in supply may result in cancellation of the contract and undelivered quantity may be sourced from other sources at risk and cost of the manufacturer/supplier.
- ii. If the supplied materials are rejected based on the final quality report, then the seller must replace the stocks within 7 days' time. If the seller fails to replace the stock against the rejected Qty within 7 days, the trade will be cancelled and

proportionate EMD and SD of the Seller will be forfeited and if such incidence is repeated more than 2 times, registration of the supplier will be cancelled from Agribazaar portal and such supplier will be blacklisted by Agribazaar to participate in future biddings.

g. Payment:

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Payment terms are different both for Institutional supplies and Harhith supplies, same will be specified in contract note on the basis of type of supplies.

h. Plant Hygiene and Right to do Plant Visit: -

Committee of HAICL appointed officials may visit the plant of any supplier before empanelment.

i. Schedule of Supply

The supplies at the end delivery point should be made within 15-20 days of the date of manufacture. No payments will be made for Items supplied after 15-20 days from date of manufacture, schedule of supply will be shared along with purchase order, supplier need to strictly adhere to that schedule.

j. Reverse Bidding and Selection Criteria: -

- i. Procurement of Ready to Eat/Processed Food items by HAICL will be via reverse bidding process, upon opening of the price bid, a reverse auction platform will be created, displaying only the item wise L1 price, no indication will be available in the portal to anybody regarding number of bids and name of bidders.
- ii. The system will display L1 landed price, at the end of the reverse auction, the L1 bidder has to submit the breakup of the prices conforming to the lowest landed rate quoted by him in the reverse auction
- iii. The L1 bidder after reverse auction will be responsible to ensure that landed rate as per the breakup of prices provided by him after the reverse auction and L1 landed rate offered by him in the reverse auction is exactly same, otherwise it may be treated as withdrawal of offer and will attract penal action
- iv. While giving the breakup, the bidder will have to consider same rate of taxes and duties as quoted while submitting the e-price bid.

k. Bid Cancellation Right: -

- a. HAICL reserves the right to cancel the bid if the bidders participating in the bidding process are not participating diligently and are not Submitting bids in a fair manner. The bidders should not submit bids, which are detrimental to the bidding process and likely to cause disruption or disturb the market equilibrium.
- b. HAICL may at its sole and absolute discretion, in the best interest of the entire bidding process and other participants at large, with or without giving notice to any such bidder and/or without assigning any reasons whatsoever, may cancel the bid or debar/disqualify such bidder in the bidding process. The decision of HAICL in this regard shall be final and binding on all the bidders.
- c. Also, HAICL reserves the right to cancel any of the bid if the participating suppliers are furnishing wrong information in the affidavit and submitting false documents and in addition the security amount and bank guarantee (if any) shall be forfeited / encased.

Further, Managing Director, HAICL in his discretion and upon facts and circumstances of each case, may impose penalty/fine as deemed fit.

B. Minimum Eligibility Criteria-Har-Hith Supplies

- i. Interested Manufacturer/processor/supplier may either be a sole proprietorship firm/ Partnership firm (duly registered under the provisions of Indian Partnership Act of 1932 as amended from time to time) or a Company (registered under the relevant provisions of Companies Act of 1956 or 2013).
- ii. Interested Manufacturer/processor/supplier must have following registrations and certifications and shall provide a self-attested copy of all the certificates with the application:
 - a. FSSAI registration
 - b. GST registration
- iii. The manufacturer/processor/supplier should have a minimum turnover of 05 crore but not less than 02 crore. Balance sheet copies duly attested / certified by the Chartered Accountant need to be submitted for the same.
- iv. The manufacturer/processor/supplier must possess all required statutory permissions from concerned State/ Central Government authorities to undertake processing activities and storage unit.
- v. The interested manufacturer/processor/supplier should not have been prosecuted for violation of rules / laws under the Essential Commodities Act or any such other laws or orders there under in any court of law and shouldn't have never been blacklisted in last 03 financial years by any State/Central Govt. body/ Public Sector Undertaking at any point of time in India. more preferably the firm (proprietor/sister concern/consortium/Joint Venture) should not never be prosecuted/blacklisted in the state of Haryana.

- vi. The interested manufacturer/processor/supplier should not be involved in any major litigation that may have an impact of affecting or compromising the delivery of services as product supplier to HAICL.
- vii. The interested manufacturer/ processor/ supplier supplying commodities mandatorily should have more than 03 year supply experience (But not be less than 02 years, in any case) in Modern Trade/General Trade, Government supply experience is preferable but not mandatory as to support MSME, Start-ups, Self Help Group and small suppliers from Haryana State, government supply experience can be relaxed for Har-Hith supplies. The proof may be in form of invoice/work order/Purchase order etc. However, MD, HAICL, reserves the right that if a less experience company approaches for empanelment, in order to seek procurement of quality products same can be considered
- viii. The successful /supplier should submit quality test report from NABL accredited lab against each supply as per specifications mentioned in contract note. The cost of testing will be borne by successful supplier.

C. Minimum Eligibility Criteria-Institutional Supplies: -

- i.) Interested Manufacturer/processor/supplier may either be a sole proprietorship firm/ Partnership firm (duly registered under the provisions of Indian Partnership Act of 1932 as amended from time to time) or a Company (registered under the relevant provisions of Companies Act of 1956 or 2013).
- ii.) Interested Manufacturer/processor/supplier must have FSSAI registration, GST registration certifications and shall provide a self-attested copy of all the certificates with the application.
- iii.) The manufacturer/processor/supplier must possess all required statutory permissions from concerned State/ Central Government authorities to undertake processing activities and storage unit.
- iv.) The interested manufacturer/processor/supplier or its firm(proprietor/sister concern/consortium/Joint venture) should not have been prosecuted for violation of rules / laws under the Essential Commodities Act or any such other laws or orders there under in any court of law and shouldn't have been blacklisted by any State/Central Govt. body/ Public Sector undertaking at any point of time in India, more preferably the firm (proprietor/sister concern/consortium) should not never be prosecuted/blacklisted in the state of Haryana on account of reasons related to quality issues or extreme delayed supply.
- v.) The interested manufacturer/processor/supplier should not be involved in any major litigation that may have an impact of affecting or compromising the delivery of services as product supplier to HAICL.

- vi.) The interested manufacturer/ processor/ supplier, supplying commodities for institutional sale should have more than 05 years mandatory supply experience in Modern Trade and General Trade (But not less than 03 years, in any case), in addition to MT/GT experience supplier should have mandatory experience in government institution supplies in similar kind of product (product for which supplier is seeking for supply against institutional requirement) as per following conditions: -

Minimum Govt. Supply Experience	Minimum Turnover(Cumulative for last 3 FY)
1 Year	30-50 crore
<6 Months	50-75 crore
3 Months	100 crores & above

Note:- Supplier/Bidder should have minimum government supply experience of either 3 months, 6 months or 1 year for the quantity he is bidding and accordingly minimum turnover (cumulative for last 03 financial years) should be as per indicated turnover value and this experience should be for the similar quantity for the above said duration i.e. 3M/6M/1 Year (but not less than 75%) for which supplier is interested to bid. Also this government supply experience should be in current or previous finance year but not beyond that period.

For example, if supplier wants to bid for supply of 500 MT quantity of any item in the year 2024 and he has 6 month experience for government supply then he should have 50-75 crore cumulative turnover for last 03 financial year (i.e. for 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23) and he must have supplied 500MT or minimum 375 MT of that particular item for 6 months at least and that government supply experience should be either in the year 2022 or in the year 2023.

- vii.) Negotiation with all the suppliers will take place as per Latest Negotiation policy of Haryana State Government related to procurement of Goods/stores (Fixed purchase & Rate Contracts), Turnkey & Services.
- viii.) The successful /supplier should submit quality test report from NABL accredited lab against each supply as per specifications mentioned in contract note. The cost of lab testing will be borne by successful supplier.
- ix.) Only those suppliers who has successfully completed the empanelment process with HAICL as per EOI parameters, prior to publication of any tender document (with successful visit of supplier Plant/Warehouse/Processing unit by HAICL appointed committee for checking the production facility/operational setup) can participate in tender process.
- x.) Only nominal quantity work order will be issued to the successful new bidder (10-15% of total tender quantity) for initial 2-3 supplies to testify the credentials, capabilities and operational efficiencies related to supply chain so as to ascertain that selected new supplier is capable enough to supply desired quantity as per requirement of institutional client.

- Xi,) In case multiple bidders matched the rate of items , post negotiation then work order will be issued to multiple suppliers in shared quantity in order to expedite the supplies as quantity is huge in case of Institutional requirement. Percentage of quantity allocated to each supplier will depend on his plant capacity as well as supply efficiency (timeline of successful delivery), calculated on basis of last 2-3 months supply experience with that particular supplier.
- XII.) Existing suppliers of HAICL who have successfully completed the empanelment process and currently supplying to institutional clients don' need to send fresh documents for empanelment but all the T&C related to supply timeline adherence and penalty clause will also be applicable on old/existing suppliers.

Note:-MD/HAICL will be the final authority related to allocation of quantity or any other relaxation related to relevant terms and conditions of this document, purely on basis of past performance of that particular supplier.

 7. Any other document required as per the eligibility clause of this document
 8. Valid supply order copy/ invoice proof/Supply agreement in lieu of Institutional supply items

E. Evaluation of applications

All received documents to be examined by the portal and scan copies to be shared with the committee of HAICL. The committee shall evaluate details submitted by the interested manufacturers/processors/suppliers and examine the documents provided vis-a-viz requirements specified in the EOI document. HAICL reserves its right to accept or reject any or all the applications and/or ask for any additional and/or missing documents from the interested manufacturer/processor/supplier (s).

The selected manufacturer/processor/supplier(s) will be informed regarding

acceptance of their application(s) and would be eligible to participate in the HAICL e-auctions.
